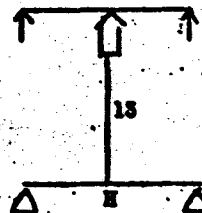

c. In the absence of special orders, A will be 6 km and C, D, E and F will be 5 km.

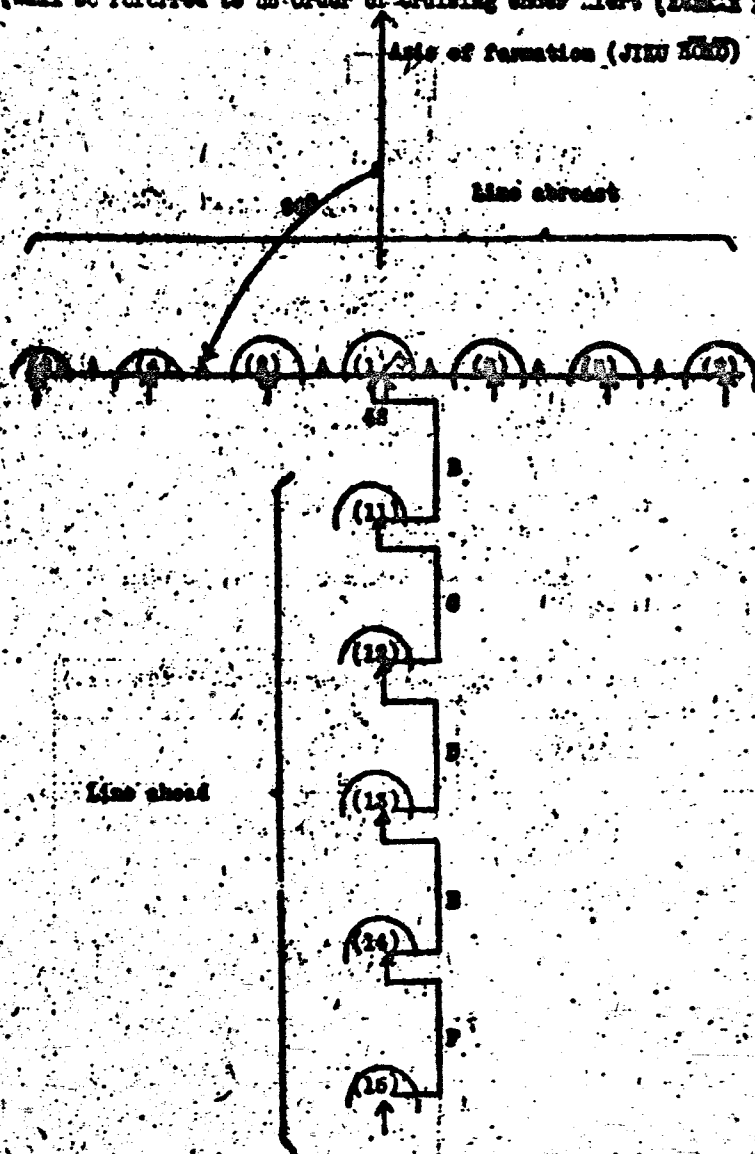

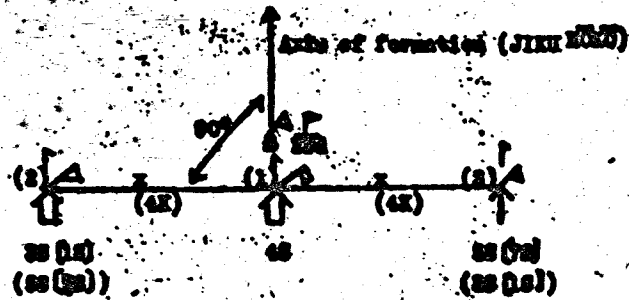

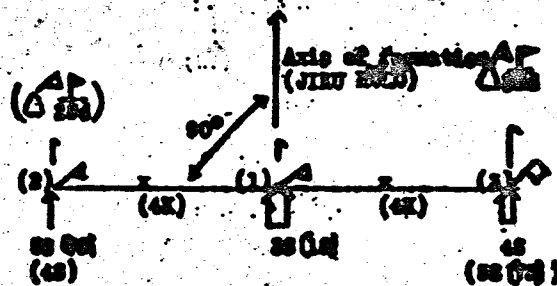

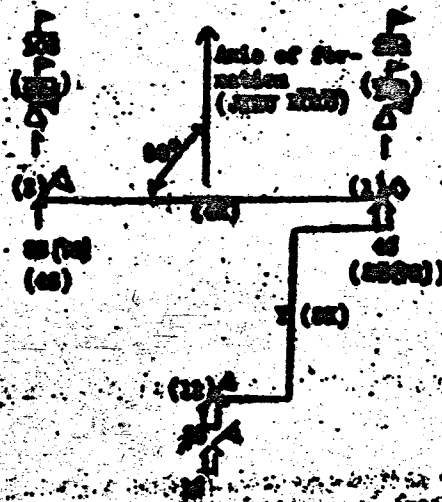

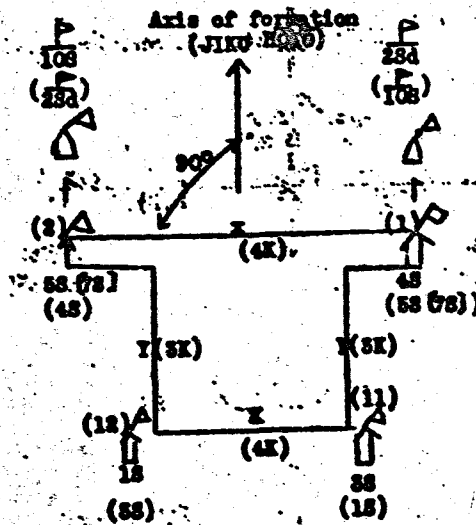

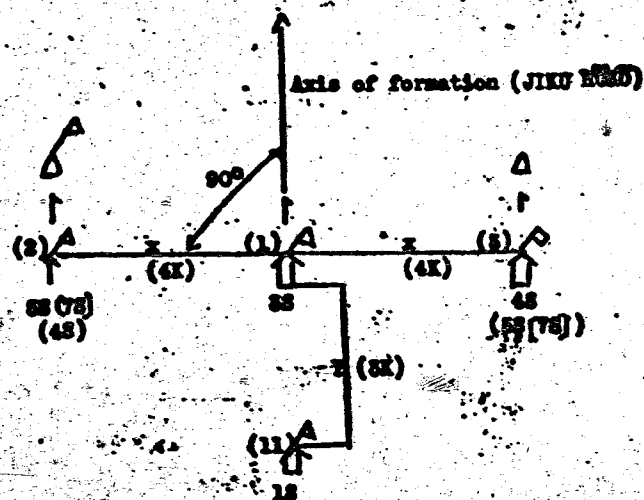

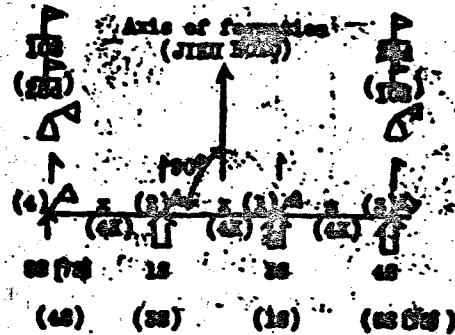

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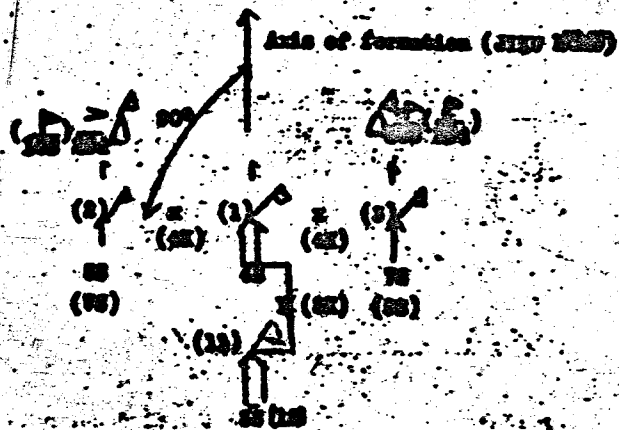

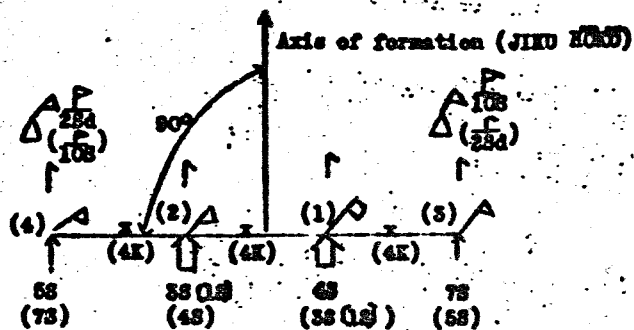

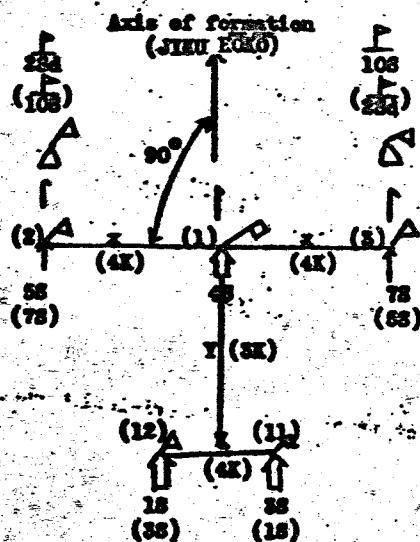

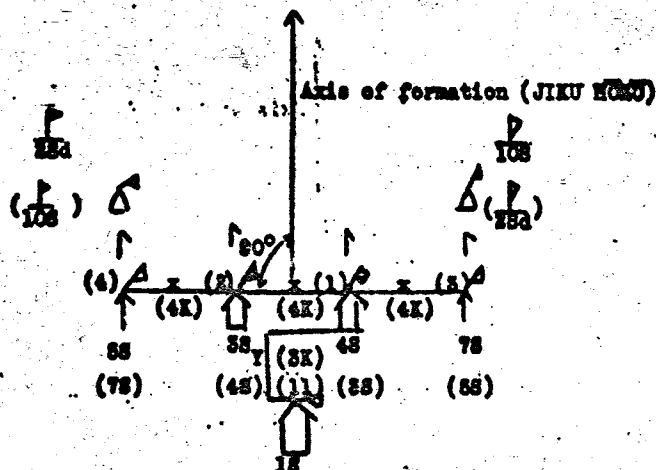

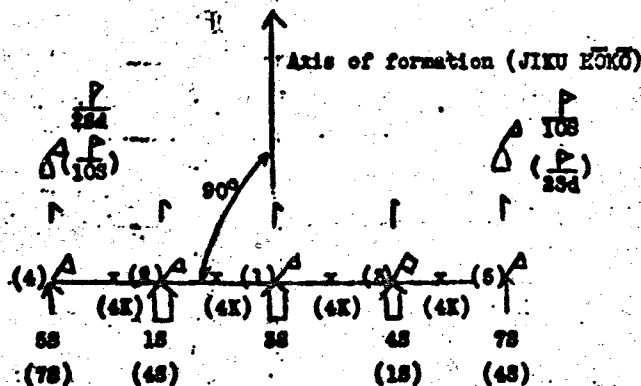

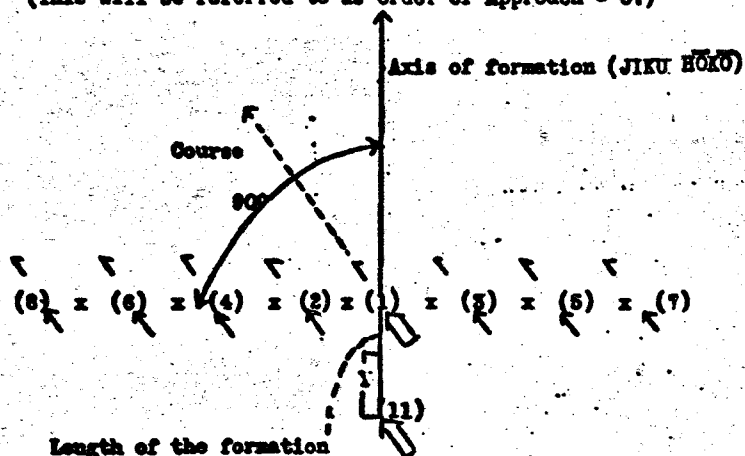
